

## **The 2009 Nationalist Coalition White Community Scholarship Competition** *“Investing In Our Future”*

### **Overview:**

With the extraordinarily high costs of higher education and the proven benefits to the various non-White communities of race-based scholarship funds (e.g., the United Negro College Fund's positive impact on the Black community), The Nationalist Coalition created an annual scholarship to reward the driven student who has demonstrated commitment to helping the White community (“activism”).

One (1) scholarship will be awarded to the most deserving student annually. The amount of this scholarship changes from year to year based on available resources; for 2009, the maximum scholarship amount will be \$1,000. The scholarship amount is based on the quality and quantity of the student's activism - with a minimum amount of \$250, and a maximum amount of \$1,000, awarded this year to the scholarship winner. This scholarship is made possible thanks to the patronage of you and all the members and supporters of the Nationalist Coalition. The more you invest in our White Community Scholarship, the more you invest in our future.

### **Privacy Notice:**

The Nationalist Coalition will not identify the direct donors in an effort to protect the privacy of those who donate; however, donors are encouraged to identify themselves if they so desire.

### **Deadline:**

The deadline for submissions is November 30th. A confirmation letter will be mailed to students who send all material required in the Application Process; incomplete submissions will be immediately rejected. The student deemed most deserving will receive the scholarship check by late December.

### **The Fine Print:**

Since activism is required to win the scholarship, it is possible that there will be no winner of the White Community Scholarship in a given year. A submission is not a guarantee of winning an award, even if there are no other submissions. We encourage student-activists to continue applying throughout their academic careers regardless of whether or not they win in a particular year.

“Activism”, broadly defined, is anything that helps advance the interests of the White community. The White Community Scholarship Review Board (WCSRB) intentionally has not made a specific definition as to what will or will not be considered “activism”; provided one is determined to do right by one's people, true activism is sure to result. The WCSRB will determine if an applicant's deeds constitute activism and the WCSRB will determine which applicant, if any, wins the award and the size of that award.

**Eligibility:**

The scholarship is open to all university/college (including graduate school) and trade/vocational school students who meet the following criteria:

- Students must be attending, or will be attending starting this year, an established university, college, or trade school.
- Students must have a proven record of helping the White community (“activism”).

**Rules:**

All submissions become the property of the Nationalist Coalition, and awards are made at the sole discretion of the administration of the WCSRB. All applications and applicants will be kept confidential and only reviewed by the WCSRB (exception to this privacy statement for anyone awarded a White Community Scholarship who must agree to allow the Nationalist Coalition website to publish his/her name, city, state, and photo - See official application). Plagiarized essay content will disqualify an applicant; essays must be your own original thoughts and writing. All applications will be verified before disbursement of funds; providing false information on your application will disqualify you from the competition. Limit one application per person per award period; duplicate or additional applications will be rejected.
